Dear Justice Bransten:

We represent Plaintiff Vijay Singh in the above-referenced action. On May 15, 2017, this Court issued a Decision and Order denying in part Defendant PGA TOUR, Inc. (“TOUR”)’s Motion for Summary Judgment and holding, *inter alia*, that Mr. Singh can proceed to trial on his cause of action for breach of implied duty of good faith and fair dealing. Earlier today, the TOUR filed a Notice of Appeal of the Court’s Decision and Order. As the Court is aware, a Notice of Appeal does not automatically stay the proceedings in this Court. This lawsuit was filed on May 8, 2013. We respectfully believe, both because the TOUR’s appeal has little chance of success and because this lawsuit has been pending for so long, that the matter should not be sidetracked by the TOUR’s action today. Accordingly, we write to request a conference to set a date for a trial and to discuss other trial-related matters.

Subject to the Court’s availability, we are available for a conference on June 13, 2017, or on another date if more convenient for the Court. We conferred with the TOUR’s counsel regarding their availability but they did not provide us with any suggested dates.
